Greetings,

My name is Patricia Mulcaster. I am a registered band member of Delaware Nation-Moravian of The Thames, and a Certified Gladue Writer from The Indigenous Perspectives Society. This letter is to inform you and your community members that I am here to help.

Gladue Rights refer to the special considerations that judges **MUST** give an Indigenous person when setting bail or during sentencing. The purpose of a Gladue report is to give the judge a complete picture of the Indigenous person before the court. The report has details about the Indigenous background and the specific circumstances that brought them to court.

I am here to support the Indigenous accused (Adult and Youth) and justice personnel in applying the sentencing principles set out in Section 718.2 (e) of the Criminal Code of Canada, and Section 38(2)(d) of the Youth Criminal Justice Act.

If you have been charged with a crime and are an Indigenous person, there are special cultural considerations that the court **MUST** take into account in assessing your case. This applies to ALL Indigenous peoples of Canada, including Status and Non-Status Indian, Inuit, and Metis, living both on or off reserve. Gladue Reports, Letters, and submissions are a right given to every Indigenous person in Canada.
